Weekly or Bi-weekly:

- Classroom Volunteer** – can coordinate times that fit your schedule
- Lunch Buddy** – will assign you an individual child; eat lunch weekly/bi-weekly with a student
- Morning Tutor** – support students academically by reading or tutoring one-on-one before lessons begin
- Physical Education Assistant** – assist YMCA instructors with PE classes on Tuesday or Thursday afternoons at Brookstone
- Office Help** – assist with general office & development tasks (filing, labels, data entry, etc)
- Library** – assist volunteer librarians with reading to students, book selection, shelving, etc.
- Fine Arts** – assist with morning violin classes, after-school choir rehearsals or art classes
- Prayer Meeting** – join with parents to pray; group meets the first and third Mondays at 8:15 a.m.

Monthly:

- CHAMPS Celebration** – provide ice cream sundae items and/or serve during monthly recognition of special awards for students (usually first Friday at lunchtime)
- Staff/Teacher Appreciation** – provide treats/food to thank the staff at Brookstone for all they do
- Make Change for Brookstone** – distribute coin collection cans at local churches or businesses to support our violin program or help count and roll the coins
- Box Tops for Education or Labels for Education** – collect box tops and labels and turn in to office
- My Coke Rewards** – register online at www.mycokerewards.com and enter coke product codes to donate to Brookstone to redeem for school items
- Garden** – assist students in a particular classroom plant, weed, and harvest their own garden plot at pre-arranged times (fall and spring planting and harvest dates)
- Alumni Society** – mentor Brookstone graduates during high school years through monthly meetings
- Friday Forum** – create a presentation for our middle schools students about your career, industry, or something of interest in the city that you are involved in

One time:

- Drama/Musical Presentations** – assist with afternoon practices, sew costumes/paint or build scenery
- Art Projects** – plan, provide materials for, and execute art project for students in the classroom
- Testing (May)** – be available during annual testing week to proctor exams or help individual students who need special assistance during testing
- Field Day (June)** – help coordinate games, prizes, etc. for a morning of fun at the end of the school year
