Step 3: We will contact you to schedule student testing and complete a family interview that includes a tour. Testing is on Tuesdays and Thursdays starting at 10:00 am.

Step 4: Brookstone will communicate if your child has been accepted or denied. Decisions will occur no sooner than March 2017 and no later than August 2017.

Frequently Asked Questions

What grade levels does Brookstone have?

Kindergarten through 8th grade.

How do you assess students?

Our primary benchmark is done at the end of the year using the Iowa Assessments. The Iowa has been used since the 1930's and accurately shows our students performance to national norms. Last year, our student's performance was well above average with students ranking above the 60th percentile. Other tools are used throughout the year to monitor and enhance a student's growth- these vary by age level. As a private school, we are not required to perform End of Grade testing.

What is your class size?

Eighteen or less. A small class is ideal, especially in the early years when students clearly benefit from the individual attention and nurturing that a small class affords.

How much is your tuition?

The cost to educate a child at Brookstone is \$8,500. Thankfully, much of this cost is subsidized by our faithful donors that allow for substantial scholarships to be given to all our students. A student's payment is determined upon information in the application. Brookstone's goal is for the monthly payment to not create a hardship for the student's family while at the same time conveying the importance of education in the home. Payments can range from \$15-\$200 per month.

How soon can parents begin enrolling for next year?

Enrollment begins in January for the following school year.

Is Brookstone accredited?

Brookstone is registered and licensed by the North Carolina Department of Non-Public Instruction. The state monitors our records annually and examines the immunization forms, academic progress, health and fire inspections. We are a member school of the Association of Christian Schools International. Locally, we are affiliated with the Greater Charlotte Association of Christian Schools.

Do you provide transportation?

No. Drop off is from 7:30 to 7:50am. Pick up is from 3:00 to 3:30pm.

Do students wear uniforms?

Yes. We have a dress code that requires navy blue pants or shorts for boys and skirts, pants or shorts for girls. Boys and girls are required to wear white shirts or blouses with collars. Students may wear navy or white sweaters. White or dark athletic shoes or dark colored casual shoes are permitted (**No** sandals, **No** boots, and **No** rollers).

Do you provide lunch?

Unfortunately, no. Parents must provide a healthy lunch and snack daily.

What is your school's calendar?

We follow the same calendar as CMS with respect to the main holidays.

Do you provide an after school program? Early Drop-off?

No. Drop off is from 7:30 to 7:50am. Pick up is from 3:00 to 3:15pm. We are continuing to extended day programming for visual arts, performing arts and athletics. These programs are running at various times through the year until 5:00pm.

Is Brookstone School a part of First Baptist Church?

No, but we do enjoy a great partnership with the church that has been beneficial to both parties.

Do you offer special education services?

Brookstone attempts to address academic issues for students who are struggling, but we have limited resources. Parents of students who need speech therapy can arrange to have a private speech/language pathologist work with their child during school hours. We currently do not have the staff available to provide interventions and accommodations for students who have previously been given an Individualized Education Plan in the public school setting.
