Frequently Asked Questions

What grade levels does Brookstone have?

Kindergarten through 8th grade.

How much is your tuition?

Tuition is need-based and calculated on a sliding scale. Payments are typically between \$15-\$250 per month and per family. This system supports our mission of offering an excellent education, regardless of your circumstances. Brookstone's goal is for the monthly payment to not create a hardship for the student's family while at the same time conveying the importance of education in the home. Full tuition is valued at \$10,000 per year. Once tuition has been determined, parents are responsible for paying the full balance by the end of the 2020-2021 school year to qualify for reenrollment the following year.

What is your class size?

Eighteen or less. A small class is ideal, especially in the early years when students clearly benefit from the individual attention and nurturing that a small class affords.

How soon can parents begin enrolling for next year?

Enrollment begins in March 2020 for the next school year.

Do you provide transportation?

No. Drop off is from 7:30 to 7:50 am. Pick up is from 3:00 to 3:30 pm.

Do you provide an after school program?

Yes. Brookstone offers after school programming, enrichment, and care until 5:00 pm on Monday - Friday. The cost of this program is \$150 per child for the entire year; \$50 for Semester 1 and \$100 for Semester 2.

Does Brookstone offer any special programs?

Yes. Brookstone provides after school enrichment activities such as athletics, performing arts, robotics, swimming, art, and tutoring.

Do students wear uniforms?

Yes. We have a dress code that requires navy blue pants or shorts for boys and skirts, pants or shorts for girls. Boys and girls are required to wear white shirts or blouses with collars. Students may wear navy or white sweaters. White or dark athletic shoes or dark colored casual shoes are permitted.

Do you provide lunch?

Unfortunately, no. Parents must provide a healthy lunch and snack daily.

What is your school's calendar?

We follow the same calendar as CMS with respect to the main holidays.

Do you provide early Drop-off?

No. Drop off is from 7:30 to 8:00 am. Pick up is from 3:00 to 3:15 pm.

Is Brookstone School a part of First Baptist Church?

No, but we do enjoy a great partnership with the church that has been beneficial to both parties.

Do you offer special education services?

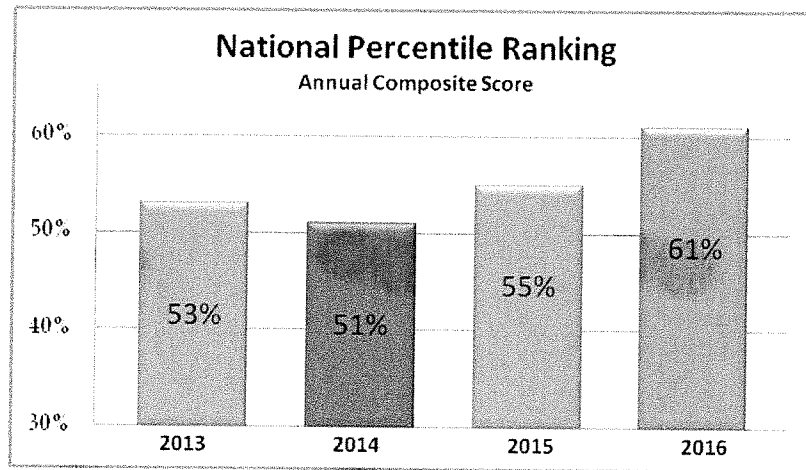
No. Certain students on an as-needed basis may be asked to participate in after school remediation and tutoring.

Is Brookstone accredited?

Brookstone is registered and licensed by the North Carolina Department of Non-Public Instruction. The state monitors our records annually and examines the immunization forms, academic progress, health and fire inspections. We are a member school of the Association of Christian Schools International. Locally, we are affiliated with the Greater Charlotte Association of Christian Schools.

How do you assess students?

Our primary benchmark is done at the end of the year using the Iowa Assessments. The Iowa has been used since the 1930's and accurately shows our students performance to national norms. Last year, our student's performance was well above average with students ranking above the 60th percentile. Other tools are used



throughout the year to monitor and enhance a student's growth- these vary by age level. As a private school, we are not required to perform End of Grade testing.

Authorized Pick-Up Form

List any adults who are permitted to pick-up your child from Brookstone Schools. It is important that this information be completed. Early Pick-Up Procedure:

When your child needs to be picked up early from school, an authorized person will come to the Main Office. Everyone will need to supply his or her Driver's License. This will allow office staff to confirm the identity of the person as well as to check the authorized pick-up list. If the person does not have their driver's license with them the child will not be released. If the person is not on the authorized pick-up form your child will NOT be released. NO EXCEPTIONS to this procedure and it includes parents and guardians. It will be used every time there is an early release pick-up.
